***HB 292** will reduce property taxes.

HB 292 funds appropriated to the WSD by the State will be used to replace the amount levied to property tax owners through patron approved supplemental school levies.

Examples:

\$602,554 in funding will eliminate the **\$350,000** WSD Maintenance and Operations Levy and allow for **\$252,554** to be placed in a facilities fund.

\$500,000 in funding will eliminate the current **\$350,000** M & O Levy and place and allow for **\$150,000** to be placed in a facilities fund.
